


UG enrollment is down at UHM and UHH, and growth is slowing at UHWO





Transfers are a large share of new entrants to UH 4-years

² UHCC transfers are students who were home-based at a UHCC anytime prior to transferring. Transfers include classified and unclassified students.




Only two campuses met performance-based funding goals for transfer

73% of UHCC classified first-time freshmen intended to transfer to a 4-year institution






But, after 3 years, among the 2014 cohort, only 8% actually transferred to a UH 4-year....and 3% transferred to a non-UH 4-year

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UHCC transfers to UH 4-years are flat while transfer to other 4-years increased






UHCC transfers exceed 60 credits at entry

Average Credit Hours³ at Graduation




